5 GLOBES (CRITERIA & INSPECTION) OF ECOTEL

[2][3]The Ecotel Certification is based on 5 areas of environmentalism, each of which is assigned by a Globe award. These five areas are referred to as the 'cornerstones of

environmental responsibility' or simply as 'Globes' which are briefly discussed below.

1. Energy conservation:

A proper framework to reduce the energy consumption in the hotel Utilizing the proper output of the product like minimum lighting is being used, the extent of involvement of the guests as well as the employees etc. which makes a difference to the final score refer fig1.

2. Water conservation:

Water conservation can implemented in many ways like adopting good management practices, educating the employees to use in a better way ,improving water quality & utilization of unwanted water to other areas like gardening, washing etc. water recycle is also a key point in water conservation. Proper implementation throughout the departments in the hotel.

3. Solid waste management (SWM):

SWM plays a major role for ecotel certificate. Here the hotel must effectively recycle & manages waste wherever generated. Proper systems are adopted for collection, recycling & disposal of these wastes in all departments of the hotels are a must for the Ecotel certificate. Proper training must be provided to all employees of the hotel including top management for better implementation of the solid waste management concept
